**Release and waiver (Please Read and sign)**

I know that kayaking is a potentially hazardous activity. I also know that occasionally I can be a knothed, but I have entered this race because I am medically able, and I have properly trained, to finish it. I also know that there could be other boat traffic on the course route and those people can occasionally be knotheds too. Therefore I assume the risk of kayaking in boat traffic and will not sue anyone if I happen to be a knothed and get in the way of Joe Sixpack or any other boat captains, commercial or private, or if those knotheds run me down. I also assume any other risks associated with kayaking this event including, but not limited to, falls, swims, contact with other participants, jellyfish, sharks, sand fleas, overzealous fishermen, pirates, brazen or crazed fans, and the effects of weather and conditions of the water. Mother Nature could very well decide to not like me today and kick my knothed, and I accept that risk. I understand I am solely responsible for my own safety while traveling to and from or participating in this event. Knothead or not, I know I am solely responsible for my own safety at all times and under all conditions during the event. Whether or not I've been a knothed today or anyone else has been a knothed today, I will not sue anyone. Furthermore, my friends and relatives, including kids, parents, grandparents, second cousins twice removed, dogs, mistresses, spiritual advisors, bookies, ex-spouses, and that third cousin on my wife's side who I never see who always seems to be unemployed and borrowing money, will not sue anyone as a result of anything that happens today. Knowing these facts and inconsideration of your acceptance of my entry, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, or anyone else who might sue on my behalf covenant not to sue, and waive, release, and discharge the sponsors or contributors to this event, any race officials, volunteers, the city and police agencies, their representatives successors or assignees from any and all claims of liability for death, personal injury, or property damage of any kind or nature whatsoever arising out of, or in the course of my participation, or anyone's knothedness. In other words, I understand that accidents happen, people can be stupid, no one is responsible for anyone else, we're free to be as knothed as we want and no one is going to get sued over it. The release form and waiver extends to all claims of every kind or nature whatsoever, foreseen and unforeseen, known and unknown, knothed or not knothed. The undersigned further grants full permission to use any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, recordings, or any other record of the event for any purpose and if someone else gets rich using my photo, I get nothing except a kick in my own knothed. Minors will be accepted with a parent's signature, because we know minors are knotheds even more than we are, and so we need their parent's approval to allow them to be knotheds.
